

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

- 7. Not to display the Halal Certificate at any premises other than for which it has been issued to.
- 8. Return the Halal Certificate to ICCV after its expiry or withdrawal.
- 9. Not to use its accreditation in such a manner as to bring ICCV into disrepute or make any statement relating to its accreditation misleading.
- 10. Retain all quality records and technical records supporting results.
